

Privacy policy for the website

1 - General provisions

1.1 This privacy policy, pursuant to art. 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 - Code for the protection of personal data, describes the management procedure of the website <http://www.tenutesrl.com> with specific reference to the handling of personal data of visitors and clients who access it.

1.2 This information is provided only for Tenute S.r.l website browsing and does not apply to other websites accessed by users through link.

1.3 By visiting the website <http://www.tenutesrl.com>, all the following terms and conditions are deemed to be accepted. If the user does not accept these terms, he/she is requested not to access or use the content and services offered through this website.

1.4 Tenute S.r.l. reserves the right to modify, add or remove parts of this privacy policy by informing the interested parties through the publication of changes on its website. Each user is required to check this page periodically to ascertain any changes since the last access to the website. In any case, the use of the website indicates the acceptance of any changes made to this policy.

1.6 By giving his/her consent to processing of personal data in accordance with the following provisions, the user permits Tenute S.r.l. to collect, process and use his/her personal data in compliance with the laws on data protection and the following provisions.

2 - Data controller

2.1 Following the access to this website, the information relating to individuals identified or identifiable may be processed.

2.2 The data controller of users' personal information who access and use the website <http://www.tenutesrl.com> is exclusively Tenute S.r.l., whose registered office is at 20122 Milan, Via A. Filippetti 39, and headquarters are at 20040 Cambiagio (MI), Via Leonardo Da Vinci 5, tax code 02893320156 and membership number of Register of Companies REA MI-934712.

3 - Place of data processing

3.1 The processing of personal data related to the services on this website are at Tenute S.r.l. office where the technical personnel are responsible for handling personal data. Where necessary, the data can be processed by the company staff responsible for the technical maintenance of the website at the headquarters of company at 20040 Cambiagio (MI), Via L. Da Vinci, 5.

4 - Types of data and consent to its handling

4.1 The data collected by Tenute S.r.l. through its website differentiates mainly between information acquired during user's website browsing and data sent intentionally by the user, for example through the registration process on the website designed for those who wish to leave their personal information in order to receive information or communications about Tenute products or services or by sending a message to Tenute e-mail address.

4.2 While browsing the website www.tenutesrl.com, the information tools and software, responsible for running this website, during their normal operation, acquire some personal data of which the diffusion is controlled in the use of the internet communication protocols. Such information is not collected to be associated with identified parties, but by its very nature could identify users through processing and association with data held by third parties. This group of data includes IP addresses or domain names of computers used by users connecting to the website, URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of requested resources, time of the request, method used to submit the application to the server, size of the file acquired in response, numerical code showing the status of the response from the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters regarding the operating system and user's computer settings.

Tenute S.r.l. can possibly use this information for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information relating to the use of the website and to check its smooth functioning. Such information is deleted immediately after the data processing has been completed. The data could be used to ascertain accountability in case of hypothetical computer crimes against the website: except in case where the data does not remain for more than 30 days on the web contacts.

4.3 An optional, unambiguous and voluntary e-mail sent to the addresses listed on this website allows the subsequent collection of the sender's email address, necessary to reply to requests, and any other personal data included in the message.

4.4 The voluntary registration at Tenute S.r.l. website through filling out a web form results in the subsequent attainment of all the information specified in the required fields and Tenute S.r.l. proceeds to process such information in accordance with this privacy policy.

4.5 By submitting the personal data, the user consents to its use by Tenute S.r.l. in order for the company to fulfil its obligations towards users and provide them with the service or the required information. In particular, including but not limited, the personal data are needed in order to: (i) create a personal account on Tenute S.r.l. website; (ii) respond to requests for information from users; (iii) access the restricted areas.

4.6 In addition to the above, where specific consent is given for processing personal data for direct marketing purposes or to promote trade pursuant to Art. 23 and 130 of Legislative Decree 196/2003, the personal data provided will be used to send promotional e-mails, written communications or advertisement material by fax or post, always for promotional purposes.

5 - Cookies

5.1 Tenute S.r.l. uses cookies within its website to improve users' browsing experience. The acceptance of cookies is not a necessary requirement in order to visit the website.

5.2 Tenute S.r.l. cannot trace any personal information through cookies if the user has not provided them directly.

5.3 Tenute S.r.l. uses temporary and permanent cookies (session cookies) exclusively for the purposes indicated in this statement. Where the user does not wish to accept the terms and conditions of Tenute S.r.l. privacy policy, he can set his computer browser excluding the usage of some or all cookies.

5.4 The use of so-called session cookies is strictly limited to the diffusion of session identifiers (random numbers generated by the server) to enable a safe and efficient review of the web site. This type of cookies is not stored permanently on user's computer, but it remains only for the duration of the browsing session and is deleted automatically by closing the browser.

5.5 Permanent cookies are stored as files on the system or on the user's mobile device for no more than 12 months and are used by Tenute S.r.l. solely to permit customization of the user's web browsing and improve the surfing of the website.

This technology allows to collect and record, anonymously, information on the web pages visited. The data collected do not identify the user and are not combined with other information in any way (i.e. the personal data provided by user during the registration). These information are solely used to track and examine the use of websites by users, collect statistics based on information gathered anonymously through the use of collective data.

5.6 The validity of the information contained in paragraphs 5.1 to 5.5 is limited to the website <http://www.tenutesrl.com> and does not extend to other websites which are accessible via hyperlink. Tenute S.r.l. does not use cookies to send promotional material to users on the basis of data collected during the web browsing or for its advertising purposes. However, the site can contain third party cookies, due to links in the website itself. The third-party cookies that might be present on the site, as well as the links through which the user can receive the information in art. 13 Legislative Decree. N. 196/2003 prepared by the owners of the respective treatments, are listed here below:

Google Maps

It is a map service provided by Google Inc. ("Google") that uses cookies that are placed on the user computer to store information and viewing preferences (such as the set zoom level).

6 - Processing methods

6.1 The personal information collected through Tenute website are processed by automated tools and are stored to achieve the purposes which they were collected for. Provided that data are collected to respond to requests for information, and where necessary, to carry out promotional activities, personal data will be processed until a request for cancellation of such information from the user is received. Specific and suitable safety measures are observed to prevent the loss of data, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorized access.

7 - Duty of disclosure of personal data

7.1 The submission of personal information by user to Tenute S.r.l. is required each time for data collection, can be necessary to achieve the purposes which are identified in this policy, or on discretionary basis. The mandatory or optional nature of submission is specified from time to time - with reference to the specific data requested - at the time data are collected, attaching a special character (*) to information of obligatory nature.

A user's refusal to communicate to Tenute S.r.l. certain information, marked as mandatory, makes impossible to achieve the main purpose of the specific collection. Such refusal could, for example, make it impossible for Tenute S.r.l. to provide the requested information or updates on products and Tenute S.r.l. services.

The provision of additional data to Tenute S.r.l., other than those marked as compulsory, is optional and has no consequences on achieving the main purpose of the collection.

8 - Disclosure of personal data to third parties

8.1 Tenute S.r.l. communicates users' personal data to third parties only where strictly necessary and functional to achieve the objectives of data processing according to the service requested by the user.

8.2 Normally, the data collected through individual services and for the purposes specified in this policy are disclosed only: (i) to persons to whom the right to access data is granted by law or regulations (public security authorities and police force); (ii) to companies for data processing and computer services (i.e. web hosting, data entry, management and maintenance of infrastructure and computer services); (iii) to persons who perform business and marketing services; (iv) to persons who perform administrative services.

8.3 Users' personal information will only be known and processed by the Tenute S.r.l. staff exclusively appointed for data processing to the extent that is strictly necessary for the performance and implementation of their duties.

8.4 No browsing data is disclosed by any means.

9 - Rights of users

9.1 The user has the right at any time to exercise his/her rights under article 7 of Legislative Decree no. 196 of 2003.

9.2 In particular, the user has the right to obtain a confirmation of the existence of personal data concerning him/her, and their communication in a comprehensible way, even where data are not recorded yet. The user has also the right to obtain the source of personal data, of purposes and methods of its handling as well as updating, reorganisation or incorporation of data when requested.

9.3 The user has the right to obtain the cancellation, anonymization or blocking the data unlawfully processed, including data which do not need to be kept for the purposes for which they were collected or subsequently processed.

9.4 In conclusion, the user has the right to object, in whole or in part: (i) for genuine reasons to the processing of personal data, if pertinent to collection purposes (ii) to the processing of personal data for purposes of sending promotional materials or direct selling or for carrying out market research or commercial communication.
